




The Capital of India is New Delhi

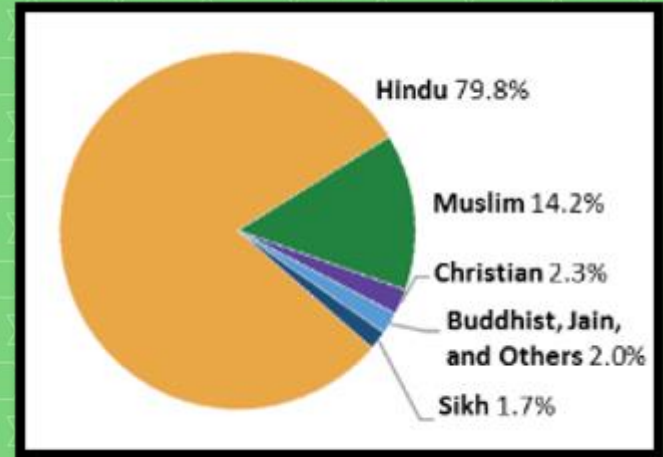
Other popular parts of India are Punjab, Goa, Rajasthan ,Maharashtra and Karnataka

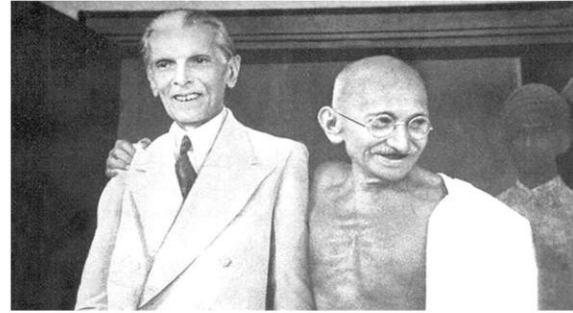
