At 16

## Academic

### A levels

Mostly in school, Sixth Forms and some colleges.

Need to have enjoyed your GCSE subject, like independent study, be able to get your homework done.

Exam assessment at the end of two years

## Vocational

### General: BTEC/OCR

Mostly in colleges but offered in some schools and can be done alongside A Levels

Need to have an idea of a job area you are interested in.

Course work, some final assessment and work placement

## Work-based

### Apprenticeships

Done on an employers premises with some time at a college or similar. Will get paid.

Need to know this is the job area you want to work in as you are being trained to do this job.

Learning through doing the job, some time learning at a college or similar, some written assessment.

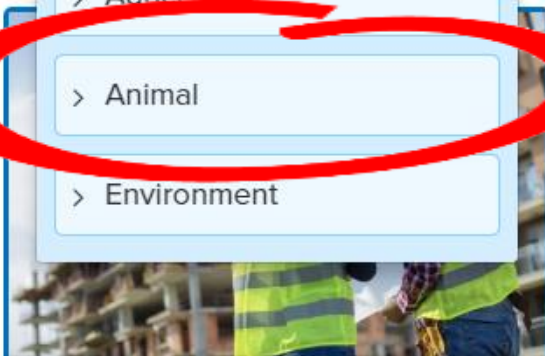

*Salary range: £15,000 to £40,000*

Animal technicians look after animals in laboratories.

*Salary range: £13,500 to £27,000*

Assistance dog trainers and instructors train dogs to help people maintain their independence.

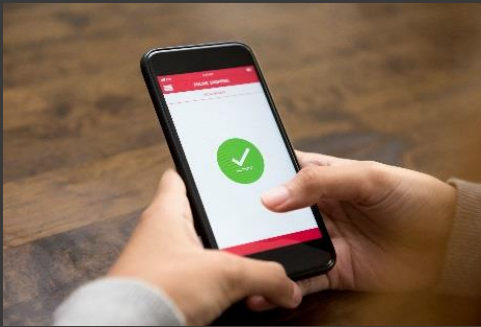

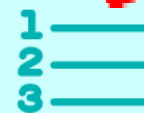

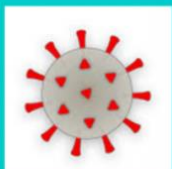
